
- Installation Guidelines


When installing an AHCON Safety Cage:

- Secure the cage to the floor with the supplied concrete screws.
 - Proper anchoring ensures the cage stays in place in case of a violent tire explosion.
- Maintain correct safety distances:
 - Keep 1 meter clearance to all sides from walls, machinery, or other permanent structures.
 - The yellow zone in the figure shows this area.

No walls or fixed equipment are allowed within the yellow zone, as **pressure waves** from a tire explosion can reflect, increasing damage and **safety risks** to personnel.

- Safety Zone Guidelines for Tire Inflation

When inflating tires in the safety cage:

- No personnel or loose objects may be inside the safety zone when tire pressure exceeds 1.0 bar.
- You may only enter the safety zone once inflation is completely finished.
- Safety distances:

o Front and rear: 1 meter

Each side: 3 meters

o The red zone in the figure below shows these distances.

Being inside the safety zone during inflation poses a **serious risk** in the event of a tire explosion.

Recommendation: Clearly mark the safety zone on the floor around the cage to make it visible for both operators and other workshop personnel.
